

EMISSION CONSENT ORDER

With reference to the Online Application ID.4726559, dated 01.05.2021 of M/s Sona Sati Organics Pvt. Ltd., At-Rajapatti Kothi, P.O.-Rajapatti, P.S.-Baikunthpur, Dist.-Gopalganj-841420 for the consent u/s 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, for he/they is/are granted consent to operate his/there plant of Molasses based as well as grain based Ethanol (Distillery) units for Molasses based Existing unit with Capacity of Ethanol-75 KLPD and Grain based unit with Capacity of Ethanol-125 KLPD At-Rajapatti Kothi, P.O.-Rajapatti, P.S.-Baikunthpur, Dist.-Gopalganj-841420 for the period of five years from the date of issue subject to the following conditions:-

- 1 That, he/they shall not make any alteration, addition, deletion or modification in the plant without the prior clearance from the Board and shall also abide by the obligations under sections 24,31 and 33A of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and further shall extend co-operation to the Board in performing its functions entrusted under sections 24, 25 and 26 of the Act ;
- 2 That, he /they shall comply with the requirements of rule 14 of the Environment Protection Rules, 1986; provisions (whichever applicable of the Hazardous and Others Wastes (Management, Handling & Transboundary Movement), Rules 2016; rules 4,5,7,8,10,11,12,13,15,17 and 18 of the Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemical Rules, 1989; and the provisions of the Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991, whichever is applicable;
- 3 That, he/they shall monitor his/their emission(s) regularly and the ambient air quality from representative points regularly and shall maintain its quality in conformity with Board's standards and shall produce its proof, as and when asked for;
- 4 That, he/they shall submit application for consent again 30 days before the expiration of the period of consent or within 30 days from the date of receipt of this order, whichever is applicable.
- 5 That, the unit shall operate its air pollution control devises (Multi-cyclone and wet scrubber) regularly;
- 6 That, with reference to the Online Application no-4823925, dated 06.07.2021, the unit shall comply with the conditions imposed in the time extension of Consent-to-Establish (CTE) for the period up to 12-months vide ref. no.-1056, dated 08.07.2021.
- 7 That, the unit shall use rotary drier for the blending of rice husk with concentrated spent wash for feeding into incineration boiler in edition with direct feeding of concentrated spent wash to the boiler;
- 8 That, the unit shall install online continuous monitoring system (24x7) for the emission and shall ensure the connectivity with the server of BSPCB & CPCB.
- 9 That, the unit shall measure Ambient Air Quality (AAQ) including Ambient Noise Level report and submit them to the Board and MoEF & CC accordingly. These reports shall conform to the standard as prescribed by CPCB.

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- 10 That, the unit shall monitor analysis report of Benzene and VOCs parameters in their distillation section, Ethanol storage section and loading/ un-loading area quarterly and submit to the Board accordingly .
 - 11 That, the unit shall comply with the conditions imposed in environmental clearance issued by MoEF & CC on dated 18.01.2019.
 - 12 That, the unit shall ensure the proper management of fermentation house, no longer retention of fermented wash etc to avoid generation of putrefying micro-organism as to control odor problems and to protect near by school/local ecology etc. of the area.
 - 13 That, the unit shall comply with the provisions of Environmental clearance issued on dated 18.01.2019 by MoEF & CC under Environmental (Protection) Rules, 1986.
 - 14 That, the unit shall comply with the provisions and conditions imposed in the E C issued under the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986 and directions issued either by BSPCB/CPCB and submit compliance report to the Board.
 - 15 That, the unit shall submit Environmental statement for the each financial year in the 31st March every year under the Environmental (Protection) Rules, 1986.
 - 16 That, the unit shall ensure to transport boiler ash/ other solid wastes safely under cover system for their disposal as per norms.
 - 17 That, the unit shall maintain good house keeping and storage of rice husk/grains dust in covered shed to avoid fugitive emission due to blow of wind and their handling.
 - 18 That, the unit shall develop green belt with adequate width inside the campus covering 33% of total project area and shall be maintained as per the conditions imposed in environmental clearance under Environmental (Protection) Rules, 1986.
